## Netherlands - AMSTERDAM

Cycling a Brompton through Greater Kyoto is an exercise in slow travel at its finest. The compact fold makes it effortless to weave between trains, quiet suburbs, and historic districts, unfolding seamlessly into rides along the Kamo River and narrow lanes lined with wooden machiya houses.

Beyond the temples, the pace softens in Uji and Arashiyama, where green tea fields, bamboo groves, and riverside paths reward unhurried pedalling. Kyoto's cyclist-friendly infrastructure and disciplined road culture suit the Brompton perfectly, turning everyday transitions into part of the journey. Here, cycling is not about speed, but about rhythm, detail, and respect for place.
